## Keeping safe this Christmas

Accidents can easily happen with all the excitement that comes with Christmas time. Here are a few safety tips from the Royal Society for the Prevention of Accidents (ROSPA) to share with families in your setting, helping to keep children safe this festive season

1. Make sure you buy toys from reputable retailers that have complied to safety standards
2. Look out for small items that could be a choking hazard, such as button batteries, burst balloons and items fallen off the Christmas tree.
3. If you have old Christmas lights consider buying new ones that comply with higher safety standards and don't let children play with them
4. Keep decorations and cards away from fires and other heat sources such as light fittings
5. Give yourself plenty of time to cook the Christmas dinner to avoid rushing and making any spills
6. Beware of trailing cables and wires to avoid any trips and falls
7. Do not drink and drive and plan long journeys ahead so you aren't driving whilst tired
