



On-Going Tasks for Home: Autumn Term

Should you want to undertake additional tasks at home, the following will be beneficial to your child's learning.

Year 1:

- Practise chanting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Practise your suggested skills on Sumdog.
- Practise your year group spellings on Spelling Shed.
- Draw a story map for a tale about a woolly mammoth.



Year 2:

- Practise your 2, 5 and 10 times tables on Times Tables Rock Stars.
- Practise your suggested skills on Sumdog.
- Practise your year group spellings on Spelling Shed.
- Write a story about a woolly mammoth, including expanded noun phrases to describe the character(s).

Year 3:

- Practise your 3, 4 and 8 times tables on Times Tables Rock Stars.
- Practise your suggested skills on Sumdog.
- Practise your year group spellings on Spelling Shed.
- Write a story about a woolly mammoth, including similes to describe the setting.



Write a list of five questions that you would like to ask a person from the Stone Age.

Create a meal that a Stone Age, Bronze Age or Iron Age person might have eaten, only using ingredients that might have been available to them.

Make a giant woolly mammoth! What materials will you use to create the structure? Does your mammoth have a name?

Find out about jewellery in the Bronze Age. Can you create your own?
