Grampound PFA - Bags2School

As part of our fundraising this term Grampound with Creed PFA have joined the Bags2School scheme. We **DO NOT** accept:

- Duvets and blankets
- · Pillows and cushions
- · Carpets, rugs and mats (including bath, shower and toilet mats)
- · Soiled, painted, ripped or wet clothing
- · School uniforms with and without logo
- Corporate clothing and workwear
- Textile off cuts, yarns or threaded material
