Message from Ms Jarrett

Dear parents and carers,

I hope everyone has had a wonderful half term break and managed to get some time to relax fully. The children have returned with renewed vigour and positivity for their learning which has been wonderful to see.

Thank you so much for your understanding over the closure of the school on Friday 18th February. Storm Eunice was just as bad as predicted in most areas and I was very thankful that our staff and families could be safe inside and not travelling to and from school.

This week has been our Book Week, focusing on Cornwall, Cornish books, Art and a trip to the Tate at St Ives. Our World Book Day was a chance to concentrate on our favourite Cornish stories. It was an amazing day with some real focus on the love of reading and a time to share and discuss our chosen books.

Our whole school trip to the Tate was very successful and the children learned a huge amount about Cornish artists such as Barbara Hepworth. The resulting artwork produced after this inspirational trip was quite breath taking! I'm sure you will have a chance to see some on Class Dojo.

As you will know, the rules around Covid have changed recently and I just wanted to confirm that schools have not changed their approach around self-isolation after a positive test result ... If a member of staff or a pupil test positive for Covid, we still expect that they will not come to school for the period of self-isolation.

This is 10 days, unless two consecutive negative lateral flow tests are obtained after day 5 (24 hours apart) at which point the self-isolation can end.

I'm sure that you will understand this is to keep all staff and children safe as we have those with medical vulnerabilities within our school community.

Your School Nurse

Your child can have access to a School Nurse at any time if you have any health concerns, in addition your School Nurse offers a full health assessment in reception and year 6.

The School Nurse can check:

- Your child is growing healthily and support with healthy eating
- Support with access to dental care and general support for dental hygiene
- Help with day / night time wetting or soiling
- Provide information about immunisations
- Guidance re healthy lifestyles
- Support with general hygiene issues including head lice and worms
- Support with general emotional health issues
- Support to access other health professionals
- Routines, including sleep

Additionally in Year 6:




- Friendships
- Relationships
- Development, including periods and puberty
- Access to specialist services – including dietician, healthy weight programmes and voluntary services
- Developmental issues
- Transition to secondary school
- Healthy lifestyles
