Rugby Slalom

Put out 5 cones, 1m apart. Place a rugby ball on a start line. On go, player picks up the rugby ball and runs with it, holding it in two hands, in and out of the cones to the end and then back again to the start line, where the ball is touched down on the line.

Keep repeating for a minute.

Score – 1 point for each complete circuit from start line and back to start line plus .1 point for each cone passed e.g. a score may be 5.3 or 5.9 .
